

COVID-19 Health & Safety Protocols

Rock, Reggae & Relief 2021 is a benefit music festival taking place on Forbes Avenue in downtown Pittsburgh on Saturday, August 28, 2021. Safety is the number one concern for our attendees, musicians, staff and volunteers.

The following COVID-19 safety plan outlines the efforts the event production team is taking to make this year's event a safer experience for all. *This plan serves as a starting point, taking into account that local and state health regulations may change as the event date approaches.*

Outdoor Open-Air Event

This is an outdoor event with ample air flow. Indoor spaces are limited to adjoining restaurants that would be operating at current state-mandated capacity levels.

Masks Required

All guests are required to wear a mask during the event, unless actively eating or drinking. Extra masks will be made available as needed.

Sanitation Stations

Guests can access 14 various hand sanitizing stations that will be located throughout the event space. In addition, full washrooms will be available to guests at the adjoining restaurants.

Contactless Entry

The event's mobile ticketing and scanning platform allows for entrance without the exchange of physical tickets.

Limited Occupancy

Ticket sales will be limited to accommodate current Pennsylvania state restrictions for outdoor public gatherings.

Temperature Checks

Fans will be asked to submit to contactless temperature checks before entering the venue.

Health Signage

Signage will be posted in highly visible locations, including entrances, restrooms and elsewhere that promote mask usage, hand hygiene and social distancing

Physical Distancing in Food & Drink Lines

Food and drink lines will be marked with 6ft indicators to allow for adequate social distancing. Online food & drink ordering will be available to reduce the number of people in line.

Routine Cleaning of Common Spaces

Janitorial staff will be available on-site to sanitize frequent high-touch areas.

Health Screening Questionnaire

All attendees and staff will be required to fill out a digital health screening questionnaire prior to entry to confirm they are not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or have recently been exposed to someone with COVID-19.

This plan was developed with recommendations from Ticketmaster as well as CDC guidelines for large gatherings.
